Then two years later came the final design in that range, the 386, which was really the best of the bunch. For by that time, Nautor had learned a lot about building and finishing boats, the fittings were improved, and so forth.”

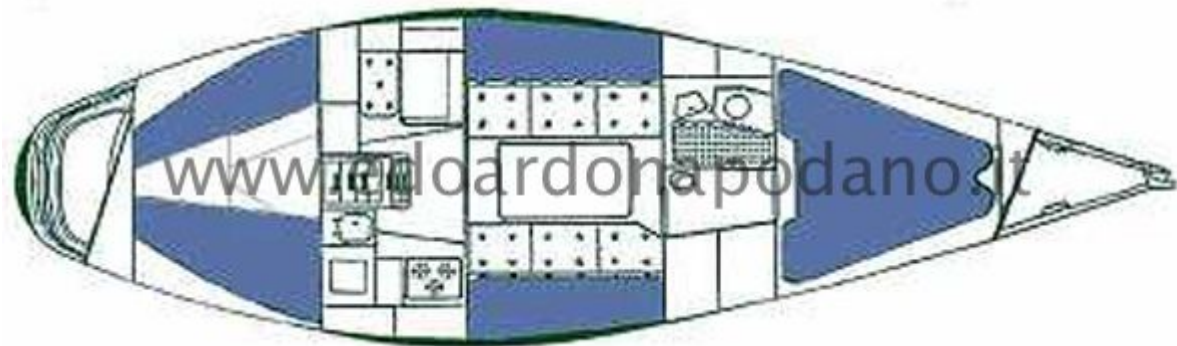
